## **Action Items:**

- Patrick will look into SWAGG we could purchase.

## **Discussion:**

Firecracker Run: Will use App for timing. Give out sparklers to everyone, fireworks to winners as in previous years. Looking for volunteers.

Clock is here! We tested it and it works great.

We are requesting a grant for the Oregon's Adventure Coast. They want projects that promote at least 2 nights stay. Ideas include: PSA's to other areas, contact running clubs in other areas, see how many out-of-town folks are following on Facebook, do Facebook boost.

PSA's for July series. Do one for the Triple Crown and then one for each individual race. Will be radio & TV.

Discussion of cost for Triple Crown. We have applied for a grant to pay for the medals. Should the cost of the Triple Crown cover just the medal or should we charge extra? Group thought it would be confusing to charge for both. Triple Crown medals cost \$30 each, have ordered \$100. Next year maybe do something like a mug or beanie. Push registration at Firecracker!

Figure out ways to get results done more quickly. Might work with two tablets so one is still collecting times while the other is doing awards. Registration – minimally 3 people. Next year charge more race-day registration. Also have early-bird special charging less for early.

Whiskey Run Trails – have had break-ins at vehicles at parking lots. Are patrolling. They're open to runners as long as they don't wear ear buds & don't run when it's muddy. We could do a run there. Should promote their events on our Facebook page.

A Master's group is starting at SWOCC. We could help promote that.

Amarissa is using Mailchimp for sending out e-mails.

SWAG- getting low on gear. Patrick is going to look into getting some good quality shirts etc. to sell. We could bring them to races & let people direct purchase on-line.
